# The plan of action chalked out by IQAC for the academic year 2005-2006.

During the academic year 2005-2006 the first meeting of the IQAC was held on 15th June 2005. In this meeting there was a discussion on the quality enhancement of different aspects of the college viz. academic, administrative and infrastructural aspects. Regarding the quality enhancement of these aspects, the following plan of action was worked out.

# 1) The academic activities:

It was decided that for the overall academic development of the college, curricular, co-curricular and extra-cur icular activities should be performed successfully within the prescribed time limit. For the performance of these activities the academic calendar should be worked out. If necessary, extra time should be given for the successful completion of the activities. Fig. in case of teaching work, necessary extra periods should be engaged. Even for effective teaching work, lectures of the guest lecturers, senior faculty be arranged for the benefit of students. Internal exams, like terminal examination, pre-annual examination should be conducted. For the performance of co-curricular activities different confests should be organized. These will include

elecution contest, essay contest, debating contest, sports contest etc. It has also been decided to organize different cultural activities during this year. Regarding the performance of extra curricular activities it has been decided to organize fectures, contests, workshops in collaboration with private / public / voluntary organizations. It has also been decided to undertake new and verted activities under the NSS regular and special camp activities during this year. While performing all these activities, the student would be considered as a central point.

#### 2) The administrative activities:

For carrying out all activities successfully, it is proosed to organize and constitute different sub-committees. The sub-committees will carry out all curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities as per the plan chalked out by them. They will be supervised and guided by the Principal. Even for a good development in teaching and non-teaching works, there will be different sub-committees working under the control of the Principal. One important thing to mention here is that in most of these sub-committees there will be participation of students also in the decision making process.

# 3) The infrastructural activities:

During this academic year the college has been shifted in its own new building and therefore it has been decided to make available a good number of infrastructura, facilities in this new building. These include-regular classrooms, departmental classrooms, library, reading hall, periodical section, gyinkhana / NSS rooms, common hall, auditorium, ladies' room, guest room, office room, Principal's cabin, separate toilet facilities for boy and girl students, teaching and non-teaching staffs etc. It has also been decided to purchase necessary furniture, books and computer sets.

# The outcome achieved by the end of the year

As per the plan devised by the IQAC in its first meeting all academic / administrative and infrastructural works have been undertaken and completed successfully during the given period. Even though, there were a few difficulties in carrying out some of the activities in the new building of the college, these difficulties were removed by a better co-ordination among the parent-institution, Principal, teachers, administrative staff, students and guardians.

- Conducting different internal exams, like terminal, preannual and periodical tests besides regular university annual exam for the benefit of students.
- Organizations of different cult tral activities. These include -welcome function, annual prize distribution ceremony, music, dance, singing contests etc.

- Organization of different programmes like superstition eradication, social reformation activities, literacy propagation etc.
- 11) Performance of different sports and gymnastic activities for the development of students. These include indoor and outdoor games, participation of students in the inter-college, zonal level sports contests. The athletic and team sports have been carried out under this activity.

In a nutshell, almost all curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities performed by the college are closely concerned with the goals and objectives of the college.

The assessment of teacher by students has been done on the basis of students' feedback on teacher. Even students feedback on course/s taught in the college, subjects taught, annual / terminal exam. System, college infrastructure, library / Gymkhana facilities, sports activities in the college, college campus has been collected and the necessary action has been taken by the institution for settling the difficulties and suggestions given in the feedback for the academic / administrative and infrastructural development of the college.

# 24) Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates:

During this year the college has not undertaken any computerization for office / library etc. purposes. However, during the next year the college wishes to introduce computerization in respect of maximum office works and library works.

# 25) Increase in the infrastructural facilities;

Since the college is shifted in its own newly constructed building recently, the necessary maximum infrastructural facilities have been made available. These include necessary classroom for B.A.I, II, III compulsory / optional subjects and departmental classrooms at T.Y.B.A. special level for the subjects of Marathi, Hindi, English and History. N.S.S. / Gymkhana rooms have also been made available. Furniture / equipments necessary for teaching purpose have also been made available, Library, Office room of the college, Principal's cabin, staffroom. Ladies common Hall / Boys common Hall, / Separate toilet facilities for girl / boy students for teaching / administrative staff have been provided. A playground has been well - developed at this new place for carrying out different sports activities.

The administrative staff of the college has undergone computer operation training course. Some of the students in the college have joined nearby computer institutes and have been doing their different certificate / diploma level computer courses.

Some needy and poor students in the college have been given concession in admission fee / tuition fee etc. The students aid fund has been helpful to some students for meeting their needs of expenses on monthly S.T.bus passes / for purchasing notebooks /textbooks of compulsory subjects.

The Alumni Association in the college has made available some sport and gymnastic activities instruments for the students of the college. Ahead to this, it has also decided to organize career orientation services for the students.

# 30) Activities and sports from the parent teacher organisation:

The college has not constituted the parent teacher organization. Because every year the college invites the parents' meet for discussing problems and new ideas regarding the development of their son or daughter. In such a meeting the parents extend their co-operation for settling any difficulty in respect of academic / infrastructural or administrative works of the college.

The parents' meeting creates a healthy atmosphere necessary for the progress of students and ultimately the cellege.

# 31) Health services:

The college has made available first-aid-box for students. Regarding the maintenance of good health, the Director of Physical Education guides to students from time to time, Sometimes medical officers from near by hospitals are also invited to instruct students regarding prevention of diseases, availing of nutritional food, good habits, addiction-free life, physical exercise etc.

# 32) Performance in sports activities:

During this academic year the college organized sports Festival. In this festival both girl and boy students have shown their active participation both in team as well as athletic sports contests such as Kabbaddi, Kho-Kho, cricket, Chess, disc throw, Put- up throw, running etc,

In addition to the above ,some students have participated in inter-college / zonal / university level contests also. Especially in the game of wrestling students have claimed honors and prizes at zonal/inter-zonal levels.

The college meets up travelling expenses of outstanding sports persons for participating in contest. It has also provided sports man's dress, sports shoes, sports trousers free of charge to such students. Such sports men are also awarded prizes in cash/certificates / medals / shields etc. on the occasion of Annual Prize distribution Function in the college.
