During the academic year 2006 - 2007, the first meeting of IQAC was held on 22nd June 2006, In this meeting discussion took place on the subjects of continuation of NAAC work equal the development of quality of NAAC work. It included academic, administrative and infrastructural aspects. For the enhancement of quality of these things the plan of action was worked out as follows :

1) **The academic activities :-**

With regard to the academic activities, it was decided that all academic activities should be carried out within the given time limit successfully. The curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities should be planned and completed successfully. As per the plan the academic calendar should be framed. For completing the academic activities within the prescribed time, extra work should be done, for example for completing teaching work in time extra periods should be engaged. For effective guidance to students regarding their subjects, the lectures of visiting faculties should be engaged. For evaluating the performance of



students terminal, pre-annual exams should be organized. For effective teaching of the subject necessary workshops, seminars etc. should be organized. In respect of co-curricular activities, the contests like essay-writing, debating, elocution, good hand writing, correct - writing in English, Marathi, Hindi etc should be organized. In case of extra-curricular activities it has been decided to organize workshops, seminars, contests, lectures of speaker in different fields etc. It was also been decided to perform different activities under Lead College Scheme for NSS/language skill development of students. It was also been planned to carry out sports and gymkhana activities for the benefit of students.

2) **The administrative activities :-**

For the performance of all academic activities, it was decided to form sub-committees activity wise. These committees will work under the guidance and supervision of the principal. In all these committees so that there will be

good interaction between the students and teachers while carrying out any particular activity.

3) **The infrastructural activities :-**

During this academic year, it was decided to develop the basic amenities and facilities of infrastructure for the benefit of students. The provision of computer in library, office, principal's cabin, the provision of gymnasium room reading hall etc should be made . It was also decided to purchase text/reference books subject wise.

**The outcome achieved by the end of the year**

As per the plan chalked out in the first meeting of IQAC, the works related to academic, administrative and infrastructural aspects were carried out successfully within the time limit given.

## Part - B

The goal and mission of the college are as follows :

- VI) To provide degree education for uplifting the standard of living. In accordance with the above goals and



mission of the college the following activities have been carried out by the college during the academic year 2006-2007.

- 1) Completion of teaching work as per the teaching plan and prescribed syllabus
- 2) Engagement of extra periods, guest lectures for competitive examinations.
- 3) Engagement of special classes for the improvement of the intellectually, economically and socially backward students.
- 4) Engagement of special classes for the help of extra ordinary students.
- 5) Organization of different contests for the overall development of students.
- 6) Organization of workshops / seminars.
- 7) Conducting different internal exams like terminal, re-annual and periodical tests besides regular university annual exam for the benefit of students.

- 8) Organizations of different cultural activities, These include welcome function, annual prize distribution ceremony, music, dance, singing contests etc.
- 9) Celebration of birth / death anniversaries of national leaders / social reformers.
- 10) Organization of different programmes like superstition eradication, social reformation activities, literacy propagation etc.
- 11) Performance of different sports and gymnastic activities for the development of students. These include indoor and outdoor games, participation of students in the inter-college, zonal level sports contests. The athletic and team sports have been carried out under this activity.
- 12) A majority of activities are performed through N.S.S. and Savitribai Fule Ladies Association of the college. These include N.S.S. cam, N.S.S. regular



activities and orientation lectures for women students of the college, blood donation camp etc.

- 16) The overall campus improvement programme.

In a nutshell, almost all curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities performed by the college are closely concerned with the goals and objectives of the college.

During this academic year the college has submitted proposal for starting P.G. courses in English and Marathi subjects to Shivaji University, Kolhapur and the Government of Maharashtra.

Their views on library and gymkhana facilities have also been collected. The difficulties faced by the students have been settled on the basis of the feedback reports.

**24) Computerization of administration and the process of admission and examination results, issue of certificates :**

During this academic year the college has purchased five computer sets. These computers have been set up in library, office and principal's cabin. Most of the college information has been computerized.

**25) Increase in the infrastructural facilities :**

**26) Technology upgradation :**

Some teachers in the college have completed MS-CIT course and got necessary training in operating

computer. Most of the students have joined certificate / diploma level courses in computer education in this year.

28) **Financial aid to students :**

With the help of the students Aid Fund constituted in the college, S.T. bus passes/notebooks/textbooks of compulsory subjects have been made available to some poor and needy students. Besides this, concession in admission/tuition fees has also been given to some needy and poor students.

29) **Activities and support from the Alumni Association**

The Alumni Association in the college has donated notebooks to 25 poor students in the college.

30) **Activities and supports from the parent-teacher organization :-**

The parents teachers organization organized two meetings in this year. In these meetings there was



discussion on different problems of students. Proper solution was also suggested for setting the difficulties.

**31) Health services :**

On the occasion of N.S.S. camp one lecture was organized for maintaining good health. In case of casual injuries caused to students first aid box is provided. Lectures of guest faculties on addiction free life, yoga, physical exercises etc have been organized from time to time.

**32) Performance in sports activities :**

During this academic year students have participated in different college/university level sports contests. These included the activities like wrestling, swimming, kho- kho, Athletics, fencing etc.

Mr. Chandrakant Patil (wrestling), Mr. Arjun Magdum (Swimming) and Mr. Sandeep Patil (Fencing) have participated in the contests at college as well as university levels.

In addition to the above, in this year, the college has provided sports shoes, track suits, sports banians, game pants, T.A. /D.A. to students.

On the occasion of Annual sports festival of the college different contests of athletic and team nature have been organized. These include Cricket, Kabbaddi, Kho - Kho Athletic game (running) chess, string jump, disc throw, long jump etc.

**33) Incentives to outstanding sports persons :**

Besides T.A. and D.A. the gymkhana department of the college has provided sport shoes/track suit, game pants, T.Shirts, sports banians to outstanding sports persons. The winner sportsmen in different sports activities have also been honoured with medals / shields / cups/ certificates etc.

**34) Student's achievements and awards :**

Some students have been awarded merit scholarship from the government / university/ and from voluntary organization. Some of the students have

displayed good performance in co-curricular and extra, curricular activities, e.g. for cultural activities, elocution contest, debating contest etc. students have been honoured with certificates.

One workshop was organized for the improvement of skills of non-teaching staff during this year.

At the time of arousal of any problems between teaching - non - teaching and students communities the Grievance Redressal cell of the college settles disputes and establishes fair atmosphere among all sections.

For setting the problems of students, the students council of the college interacts with the concerned committees set up for the concerned propose. Besides this, suggestion box is also arranged for collecting suggestions, complaints of students.

From time to time there is a get - together among all these communities for the performance of different

cultural, social activities and such a get together naturally helps to generate and boost a very good and friendly relationship among all members.
