The annual exams are conducted by the University and the result of those exams are also declared by the University.

Most of the teachers in the college are computer literate and for the necessary information in respect of their subject, they avail of internet facility. A number of students have taken admission to certificate course in computer education.

The college has introduced the facility of Students Aid Fund for the help of poor and needy students. For S.T.Bus passes / admission work / note books / textbooks financial help is provided to students.

The Alumni Association of the college has donated sports kits and some sports material to the gymkhana department of the college.

The parent-teacher organization has organized three meetings during this academic year. In these meetings, discussion took place on the problems of students.

On the occasion of 'Annual Sports Festival' different contests of team and athletic nature have been organized and a number of students have shown their good performance in these sports contests.
