Presentation by the Head of the Higher Education Institution

1. Honorable chairperson of peer team visit committee Dr..... and Dr. I welcome you heartily on the behalf of college. Our college ‘Jaywant Mahavidyalaya, Ichalkaranji’ is located in Ichalkaranji, a city in Maharashtra state known for textile industries. The college was started in the year 1993 by the founder president of the parent institution Hon. Jaywantraoji Awale, the then Cabinet Minister of social welfare Maharashtra state. Our parent institution ‘Jaywantrao Awale Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, Ichalkaranji runs various education institutions. Our college is one of them. It is affiliated to Shivaji University, Kolhapur permanently. It received ZF UGC recognition and 12 B UGC Recognition in 2009. The college has two faculties Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) and Bachelor of Commerce (B.com) and one at PG level (M.A.). There are four degree programmes at B.A. level – Marathi, Hindi, English and History. For B.com. there are two programmes Advanced accountancy and Industrial Management. In addition to it The institution has started some value added courses like Balwadi Shikshan Shikshak Abhyaskram, Travel and Tourism, Basic English Grammar.
2. The institution is working with a vision of “Empowering the student from socio-economic underprivileged sections through knowledge and skill for the attainment of social justice, national integration and human and cultural values”. It has commitment to provide quality education to students to make them self reliant, employable and responsible citizens.
3. The college is located in Shahapur a part of the Ichalkaranji city where majority working class dwells.
4. These are the academic programme run by the college at UG and PG level
5. There are eleven full time permanent faculty for B.A. which is grantable and a librarian and one director of Physical Education. For non-grant faculty (B.com.). There are five full time faculties. For PG there are seven visiting faculty.
6. Every year nearly 600 students are being enrolled for various programmes run by the college. These are the details.

The faculty has published their books, creative writing and research works, as well as they contributes for textbooks, SIM published by affiliating university.

15. Infrastructure

The college has its own building with 1447 sq. mt. built up area. It has sufficient physical and academic facilities with principal's cabin, staffroom, administrative office, multipurpose halls, classrooms, ladies room, washrooms, library, gym, playground, wi-fi facility, CCTV etc.

16. Budgetary Details

The college conducts its external audit every year. The expenditure and utilization of funds of some committees like NSS, Lead college committee is audited through C.A.

17. Scholarships and Free ships

There is provision of government scholarships for students belonging to reserved category. Also there is provision of Rajashri Chhatrapati Shahu Shishyavrutti for students of EWS, 4 students financial assistance at the loss of death of their parents in Covid 19 pandemic.

Through we don't have incubation center, the faculty organizes various programmes for career counseling and guidance for the students. The faculty intimates the students about vacancies at local level to the eligible students.

19. Sports Activities

The gymkhana department avails various indoor and outdoor sports facilities. It organizes annual sports festival.

Our college has organized zonal and interzonal wrestling, kabaddi tournaments for men and women.
